WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Canton City School District ("Board") and Local 161 of the Ohio Association of Public School Employees/AFSCME Local 4, AFL-CIO ("Local 161") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board has a need for a new position titled "Truancy Specialist," and

WHEREAS, the Board and Local 161 are desirous of adjusting the collective bargaining agreement to include the Truancy Specialist position, along with an appropriate wage schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board and Local 161 have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding as follows:

1. The position of "Truancy Specialist" shall be created, effective July 1, 2015
2. Article 9.0111 B shall be modified to add "Truancy Specialist" to the "Educationally Related" positions in the classification series, alongside and equal to "School Community Worker"
3. The "Truancy Specialist" position shall be placed in Column "A" of the wage schedule
