**RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NAME OF IRA M. ALLEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO STEPHANIE RUSHIN PATRICK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education is responsible for the naming and renaming of all Board-owned facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, if the facility is named for an individual, that individual must have made an outstanding contribution to the community, county, state, or nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Leila Green Alliance of Black School Educators has approached the Canton City School District Board of Education with this proposal to honor Stephanie Rushin Patrick; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick attended Allen Elementary School, then graduated from Canton McKinley High School in 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick graduated from Central State University in 1969 with a degree in Elementary Education, then earned a Master's Degree in Counseling from Kent State University in 1974; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick began her career as an Educator teaching Language Arts at Hartford Jr. High. She also served as a guidance counselor at Hartford and McKinley High School; and

**WHEREAS**, according to her sister, Rene' Rushin, as a child attending Allen Elementary School, Stephanie Rushin Patrick, always said she would be the principal of the school when she grew up; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1980 Stephanie Rushin Patrick became the principal of Lathrop, then Allen Elementary School, and served in that position until 2004, when she was named principal of Hartford Jr. High School where she served until her official retirement in 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, during that tenure, Stephanie Rushin Patrick rose through the ranks of the education community, not only as a leader among Black educators, which she was, but also as a distinguished administrator in her own right, recognizing and growing talented educators who have left their mark on the Canton City School District and far beyond; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick was a program officer working on school desegregation, equity and professional development of educators around the state of Ohio for Kent State University; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick has been an active leader and center of influence in the broader community of Canton and Stark County; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick is the co-founder and long serving president of the Leila Green Alliance of Black School Educators, and was an officer in the Ohio Alliance of Black School Educators and the National Alliance of Black School Educators; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick has been the chairperson of the Canton Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Celebration since 1969, which remains the oldest, continuous Martin Luther King event in the state of Ohio, and made space for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission, on which she also served; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick is the chairperson of the O'Jays Scholarship and chairs its Selection Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick is on the governing board of the Community Treatment and Correction Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick was inducted into the Stark County Women's Education Hall of Fame in 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick was honored by ABCD, Inc. with the prestigious Helping Hand Award in 1992, the Martha Lottman Award from Coming Together Stark County in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick received the Ohio State Educators Award from Congressman John Boccieri in 2008 and Ohio Humanitarian Award from Governor George Voinovich in 1993; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick is a deaconess at Grace Fellowship Church in Canton, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephanie Rushin Patrick, even in retirement, continues to mentor Canton City School District administrators, and substitute for principals and teachers, thereby continuing to positively impact students who are the children and grandchildren of those which she started her career; and

**WHEREAS**, the contributions of Stephanie Rushin Patrick to the Canton City School District, the broader community and beyond are outstanding, far reaching and unique; and

**WHEREAS**, the opportunity to honor a lifelong excellence, dedication and commitment to education and the civic health of our community of this magnitude is rare and meritorious.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Canton City School District Board of Education hereby approve the re-naming of Ira M. Allen Elementary School to Stephanie Rushin Patrick Elementary School on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2020.
